The Spring City Culinary Water Improvements Project includes the replacement of approximately 10,000 feet of water main pipe with associated valves, fire hydrants, and service connections. The project also includes the construction of a new 500,000-gallon concrete tank, chlorination building, approximately 11,000 feet of new transmission lines, and upgrades to existing wells and meter stations.

This project is funded by the Drinking Water Board.
